Westchester 2025 is proposed to be a means to assist Westchester County government and the county's 45 municipalities to work in partnership so that a county-wide planning statement and local comprehensive plans can speak as one regional vision.

The website will be an interactive planning resource and toolbox that integrates the plan's elements with sections on visualization, community overviews, regional partnerships, demographics and additional tools and assets that can help decision-making and communication.
