Join staff from the Westchester County Planning Department, NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) for answers to the questions:

- How properties are affected by the updated flood hazard maps
- Property Flood Risk
- Flood Insurance
- Flood Risk Mitigation

The updated Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs) will be available for viewing. To identify and consult the appropriate map, county residents will be able to look up their property address via the Base Flood Elevation tool. The updated FIRMs, which identify at-risk areas of flooding in the Long Island Sound and Hudson River coastal municipalities of Westchester County, are used by insurance companies to determine a property's flood insurance requirements.
