February is National Prevent-a-Litter Month – Low Cost Spay/Neuter Opportunities

The New Rochelle Humane Society (NRHS) offers low cost spay/neuter certificates, which can be purchased at the shelter seven days a week. The cost of the certificate varies, depending upon the species (cat or dog) & weight of your pet. When the Spay/Neuter certificate is purchased, a list of participating veterinarian offices will be provided. Be advised that this voucher covers the spaying or neutering costs; additional costs may be associated with this procedure, and confirmation of total charges with the veterinarian is suggested.
