



**RYE BROOK**  
**SMOKE TESTING NOTIFICATION**  
**ROCK RIDGE DRIVE**  
**September 24 & 25, 2009**

Fred A. Cook Jr., Inc. has been contracted by the Village of Rye Brook to test sanitary sewer lines in your area on Rock Ridge Drive. This test involves blowing smoke into the sewer lines. This smoke will reveal places where storm and other surface waters are entering the sanitary sewer system.

A special non-toxic smoke will be used in these tests. This smoke is manufactured for this purpose. It is gray / white in color, leaves no residuals or stains and has no effects on plant and animal life. The smoke has a distinctive odor and visibility and the odor lasts only a few minutes with adequate ventilation. If you suffer from any lung or respiratory ailments, please contact us at the number below for special service.

Because the plumbing appliances in your house or building are connected to the sanitary sewer system, some of this smoke may enter your house if:

the vents connected to your building's sewer pipes are inadequate, defective, or improperly installed;

the traps under sinks, tubs, basins, showers and other drains are dry, defective, improperly installed or missing;

the pipes, connections, and seals of the wastewater drainage system in and under your building are damaged, defective, has plugs missing or are improperly installed.

All residents are advised that if traces of this smoke or its odor enter your house or building, it is an indication that gases and odors from the sewer also may enter. Correction of the source of smoke that enters your house is urgently advised.

If you observe smoke in your home, vacate the premises and immediately call it to the attention of the testing crew or Village personnel in the area performing the tests prior to ventilating the room.

**The test will be performed between September 24 & 25, 2009 between 8 am and 4pm. Notices will be given to each residence two days prior to conducting the test on their street.**
