

# 2006 HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL CLEAN-UP DAYS



## When & Where:

**September 23** (Saturday, 9am to 3pm)

**County Recycling Center, Yonkers**

(across from Stew Leonard's and Home Depot)

From the north: NYS Thruway (south) to first exit after toll, exit 6A/Stew Leonard Drive. Turn left at light.

Follow signs.

From the south: NYS Thruway (north) to exit 6A/Stew Leonard Drive (last exit before toll). Proceed straight to stop light. Turn right at light. Follow signs.

**October 27 & 28**

(Friday, 1 to 3pm & Saturday, 9am to 3pm)

**FDR State Park, Yorktown**

**November 3 & 4**

(Friday, 1 to 3pm & Saturday, 9am to 3pm)

**Playland Park, Rye**

Take I-95 to Exit 19/Playland Parkway. Proceed to end of Parkway. Follow signs.

**FREE - Get a mercury-free oral thermometer when you trade in your old mercury-filled thermometer.**

## Tips & Reminders:

Close all bags and bottles tightly.

All chemicals must be in original or labeled containers.

Place all chemicals in a sturdy box and in the trunk of your car.

**Residential chemicals only.** Materials from businesses, institutions and schools will not be accepted.



There is no fee, but pre-registration is required for 100 pounds or more of solid material or 25 gallons or more of liquid. To pre-register, call (914) 813-5425.

## Items Accepted:

*Properly labeled household chemicals, including:*

**Most Automotive Fluids** – e.g., antifreeze, brake fluid, gasoline

**Flammable Liquids** – e.g., kerosene, charcoal fluid, turpentine

**Metal, Jewelry and Furniture Polishes & Waxes; Wood Preservatives**

**Pesticides, Insecticides, Herbicides**

**Photographic & Swimming Pool Chemicals**

**Fluorescent Light Bulbs**

**Fire Extinguishers & Small Propane Tanks**  
(1 and 2 pound tanks *ONLY*)

**Rechargeable & Button Cell Batteries**

**Mercury** – e.g., thermometers and thermostats

\* **Cell Phones**

\* **Car Tires** (maximum 10)

\* **TVs, Monitors & Other Computer Hardware**

\* Before delivering cell phones, tires, TVs or monitors to a Household Chemical Clean-Up Day, first call your municipality and ask if there is a local drop-off or collection program for these items.

## Items Not Accepted:

**PAINT— Oil & Latex** – Throw away *in solid form* with household trash. Air dry and use kitty litter or waste paint hardener.

**Motor Oil** – Take to service station or motor oil retail outlet.

**Vehicle Batteries** – Take to a local scrap metal dealer or any vehicle battery retail outlet.

**Non-rechargeable Batteries** – Throw away with household trash.

**Smoke & Fire Detectors** – Throw away with household trash.

**Compressed Gas Cylinders** – e.g., helium and oxygen tanks, 20 pound BBQ tanks

**Freon & Appliances with Freon** – e.g., air conditioners, dehumidifiers

**Explosives** – e.g., flares, fireworks, ammunition

**Pharmaceutical or Medical Waste**
